**Paratransit** complements fixed route service to serve individuals with disabilities as required by federal law.

**Demand-Response** services pick riders up by request.

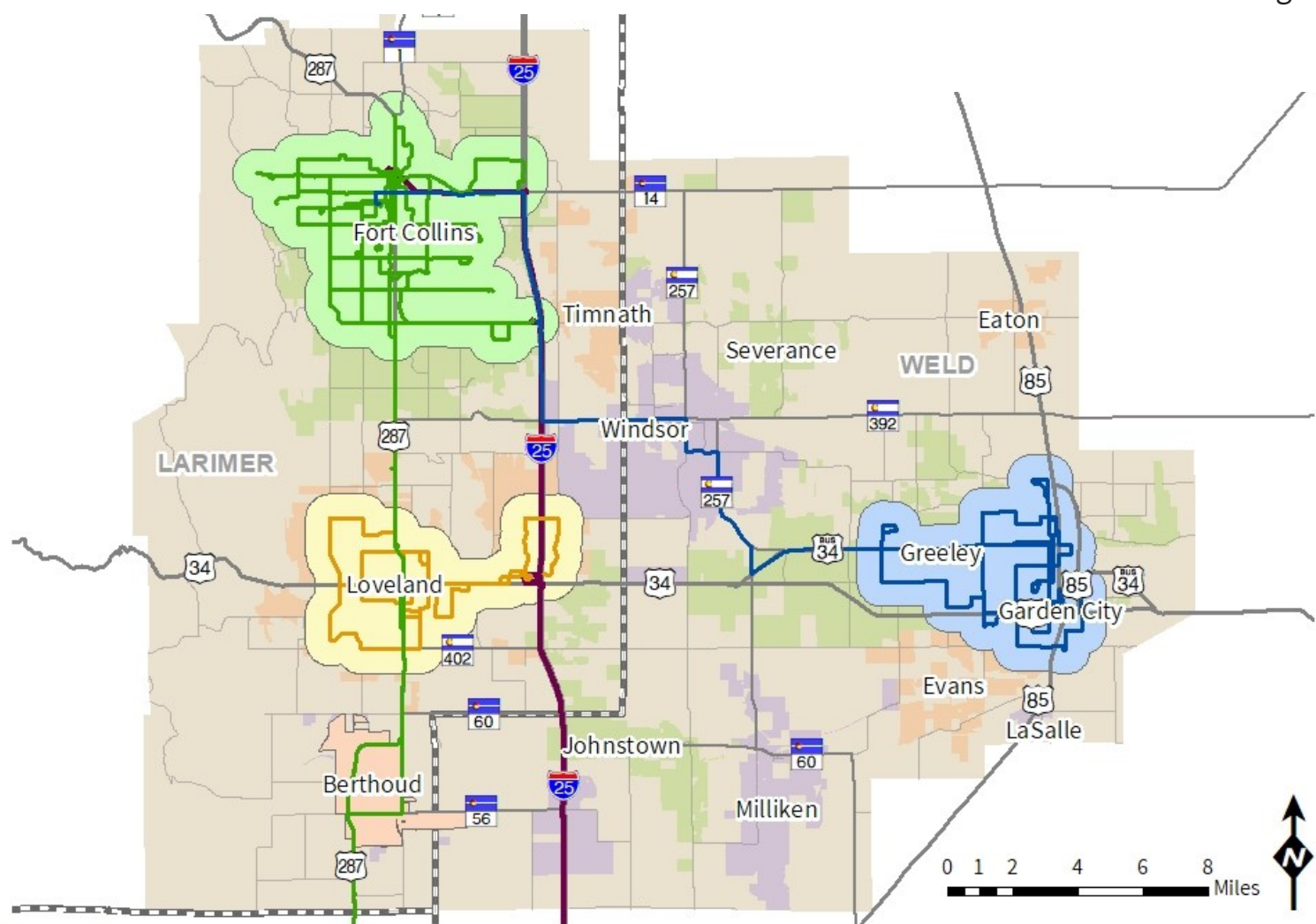
